<b>Pre-requisites:</b>	Hold a current National HRWL to perform dogging. Minimum age 18, 100 points of Identification (as per SafeWork NSW), adequate literacy & numeracy and USI.

This unit is based on the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work and is a legal requirement for any person who operates a vehicle loading crane (capacity 10 metre tonnes and above).

### Course Delivery

A learner guide and review questions will be provided to the student prior to course commencement. To fulfil the training requirements for this course, the student must read through this, complete the review questions and bring both with them on the day.

The course consists of face-to-face theory, mathematical and practical training. Students may require additional mathematical study time during the training to ensure the best possible chance of a successful outcome.

Assessment is conducted through a combination of practical demonstration and verbal or written questioning, including mathematics.

### Course Content

- Work planning & conducting routine checks
- Setting up the crane
- Transferring/moving loads
- Load calculation
- Shut down and securing the crane

### Course Requirements

- Appropriate clothing, including a hi-visibility shirt/vest and enclosed shoes or boots
- Adequate health and fitness to carry out tasks safely
- Meet all pre-requisites listed.

### Course Fees

A deposit of \$1,000 is required within 7 days of enrolment, with the balance to be paid on the second day of classroom attendance. All enrolments are considered tentative until payment of the deposit is received.

### Course Outcome

Upon successful completion participants will receive a Nationally Recognised Statement of Attainment in *TLILIC0002 - Licence to operate a vehicle loading crane (capacity 10 metre tonnes and above)* and an application for a SafeWork NSW HRW Licence.

### Important

Upon successful completion of this course, participants have 60 days to submit their application for their HRW Licence at Australia Post. Licensing fees apply.

Anyone assessed as 'not yet competent' can be reassessed on the relevant section **after 48 hours from the original assessment date, and before 90 days** have elapsed (after 90 days a full reassessment will be required).

SafeWork NSW HRW Licences are valid for 5 years.
